Insights on OSS Adoption Barriers for MSMEs & TSOs Across Europe!

Our latest study: <u>Digital Empowering MSMEs & TSOs - Research on OSS Training Offerings and Needs</u> uncovers the most critical barriers to Open-Source Software (OSS) adoption among MSMEs and Third Sector Organizations in six European countries: France, Estonia, Greece, Italy, Spain, and Poland.

Key Findings:

- **Poland**: Lack of awareness and know-how on managing OSS risks are top barriers.
- **Greece**: Comprehensive barriers including strategic commitment and technical know-how.

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- France: Technical know-how and risk management lead the barriers.
- Italy & Spain: Understanding OSS characteristics is the main challenge.

These findings emphasize the need for targeted interventions to boost OSS adoption by increasing awareness, fostering strategic commitment, enhancing technical skills, and promoting a better understanding of OSS.

The DIGITopen project is set to:

- 1. Improve digital skills in OSS tools for MSMEs & TSOs.
- 2. Enhance capacity building and synergies with VET providers.
- 3. Enrich VET providers' educational offerings in digital skills.
